### Brunswick Street Works in Your Area

Dear Resident/Business owner

#### PROJECT CHANGES TO WORKING HOURS

We would like to advise you of some changes to the Department of Transport's Brunswick Street working hours for a small component of the works.

We are now extending our working hours for the road marking component of the works to commence from **9 pm** on Thursday 17 June, weather permitting. Duration of these works will be 4 nights from **Victoria Pde to Hanover** then 4 nights from **Argyle to Cecil/Alexandra Pde**, excluding weekends. Noise will be minimal.

As these works will initially run during tram times, tram spotters will be operational from 9 pm to 12.30 am for the duration of the works, to ensure public safety and make sure there is no impact on tram services along Brunswick Street.

Yarra Council is aware and supportive of these extended working hours.

As previously advised, planned works will continue weekdays (Sunday to Thursday) at nights only from 12.30 am to 5 am: Victoria Pde to Hanover St early to mid-June; Argyle St to Cecil St on Brunswick St commencing mid/late June, dependant on weather. Sections of Brunswick St will be closed except for local access; roads will be open again during each day from 5 am. Road, bike and pedestrian detours will be clearly signed.

We will continue to keep you updated.

We appreciate your patience while we work to improve safety along this section of Brunswick Street, Fitzroy.
