

Yarra Boulevard, Richmond - Flashing light wombat crossings civil works

(In front of Melbourne Girls' College)

Works are scheduled to commence on Wednesday 5th January 2022

We will be carrying out works in your neighborhood soon and would like to share some important information.

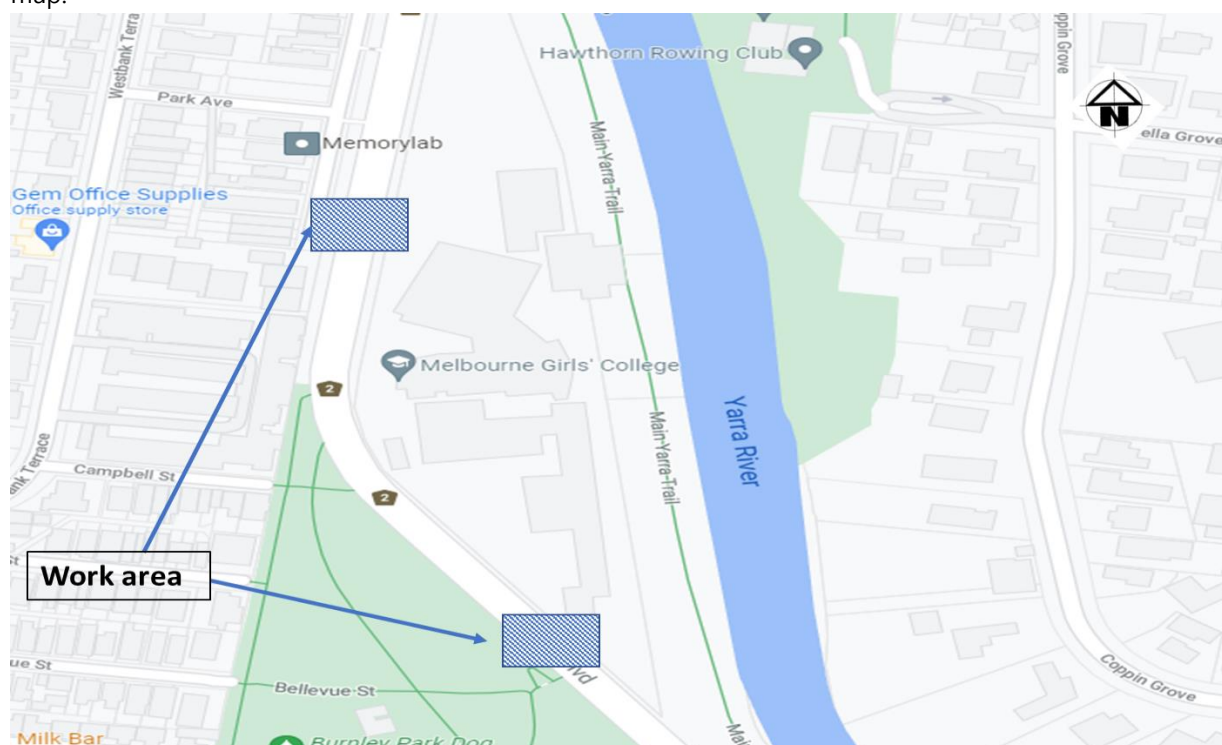
As part of a recent Local Area Place Making (LAPM) study, traffic treatments were planned for your street. These treatments have been endorsed as part of the area wide traffic management plan

What are we doing?

- Constructing two new flashing light wombat crossing (raised asphalt)
- Re-construct Kerb and channel along with installation of new drainage pits and heel-safe drain
- Tactile pavers installation and line marking to follow completed asphalt works.
- Installation of flashing pedestrian crossing lights and overhead and overhead luminaries

Where are the works happening?

The works are happening in Yarra Blvd, Richmond in front of Melbourne's Girls College as shown on the below map.



When will the work take place?

The works are scheduled to commence on Wednesday 05th of January 2022, and are expected to take five weeks to complete, subject to weather conditions. Working hours are 9am to 3:30pm on weekdays during school holidays, and from 9:30am to 2:30pm on weekdays during school days. No works will take place on weekends. There may be some noise and dust during the works, but we will try to keep this to a minimum.

Who will do the works?

Works will be carried out by Council contractor Aussie Civil. Please contact Paul Poulter on 0426 287 434.

Will I be able to access the street?

The road will be closed partially and will remain open to vehicles during working hours. Appropriate traffic management plan will be in place with suitable detours. Pedestrian access within the works zone will be maintained with the assistance of traffic controllers onsite.
