

## The Map: Critical Mass North: Spooky Edition - 27 October 2023

The route is set out below as follows – we are trying to minimise conflict on the roads and have made choices based on safety – if we need to have more than one signal cycle to get everyone through the various intersections so will need to pull over regularly and wait to riders to catch up:

### Start: State Library

Cross over from the State Library to start the ride in the bike path (on the road if there are lots of riders) on La Trobe Street



Travel North along La Trobe Street bike lane (corking at intersections) to join Victoria Parade (ride on the road) and then turn left along Nicholson Street

At the Nicholson and Gertrude Street intersection we get in the right-hand turning lane to turn right into Gertrude Street making sure to cork/block oncoming traffic that is heading south until everyone has passed through

Turn left into Brunswick Street. Follow Brunswick Street north crossing Alexander Parade travelling north along Brunswick Street/St Georges Road Street (keeping the ride together i.e. hold ride/slow down post the intersection to regroup)

Hold ride at Park Street pedestrian crossing and wait for the pedestrian crossing signal then cross right following the Capital City Trail - follow trail along past Rushall Gardens and cross over Merri Creek bridge turn right after bridge

Hold ride until all gathered at Merri Parade at the Union Street Ped crossing, cross traveling along Union Street and turning left into Park Street South

Cross right into Charles Street then immediate left into Park St then up the laneway alongside the trainline.

Turn right into Westbourne Grove and turn left into High Street – using the pedestrian signal outside the Town Hall to help us if possible

Travel along High Street turning left into Hawthorn Road and then left along Helen Street and then right onto Arthurton Street/Separation Street – we will have blockers at this intersection

Travel along Separation Street turning left into Hopetoun Street to finish in All Nations Park
